Only completed applications will be considered. Guidelines for a successful submission are below. The ***SUBMISSION DEADLINE is March 20th at midnight!***



The *application needs to include* a digital submission of a completed version of this form and corresponding artworks’ images. The files should be submitted with the title of the work and artist’s name as follows: “ARTWORK_ARTISTNAME.” To ensure that the gallery will be uniform and simpler to transport, the curators have purchased frames at sixteen inches by twenty inches. For submitted artwork to be chosen, artists must agree art will be produced or re-produced with these dimensions in mind, and with a depth of three inches or less. By signing below, the artist agrees to allow the Painted Story Children’s Gallery, based in Chattanooga, TN, to include their artwork in a year-long traveling exhibition, along with an end-of-the-year auction. The auction will consist of prints of the art included in the Gallery, and if the artist so chooses, the original work. The exhibition debuts in June, 2017 and will operate annually with new art submitted on a yearly cycle. The artist also agrees to make a number of prints of the artwork available for patrons and participants to purchase at the end-of-the-year auction or upon special request. The amount of prints required will be discussed with the artist upon selection and based on resource availability. The artists, curators, and organizers, [Christina Thongnopia](#), [Art 120](#) and the [Bethlehem Community Center](#), will divide the auction and print sales proceeds. The artist will receive 50% of the print and original artwork’s total sales, as well as publicity and marketing assistance throughout the project. Art 120, the Bethlehem Community Center, and Mrs. Thongnopia will receive the remaining percentage, to benefit programs.
